

Dear Families,

In line with the Government's Living with Covid-19 Plan and updates from the UKHSA, I would like to highlight our expectations from 1st April 2022:

If students display symptoms of a respiratory infection, including Covid-19 and a high temperature or feel unwell, they should follow the revised government advice which is to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to return to school and they no longer have a high temperature. Students who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home. Students can return to school when they feel well enough and the fever has gone.

If students have a positive Covid-19 test, they should follow government advice in that they stay at home and avoid contact with other people for three days, which is when you are most infectious.

Thank you for ensuring that your child continued to participate in twice weekly lateral flow tests. I can confirm that our request to test is removed from 1 April 2022 in line with updated government guidance.
