Dear parent/carer,

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of our uniform standards at expectations at Selston High School. I have included the information from our uniform policy for reference:

- Students are expected to wear school uniform and to maintain a smart, sensible and business like appearance at all times.
- Grey Blazer with school badge
- Either Black trousers – these must be tailored trousers or black, knee length skirt (Not pencil or stretchy style)
- Black or Grey v neck jumper (Optional)
- Plain, polishable black shoes. (Not trainers or canvas shoes, no logos or coloured soles, no high heels or boots).
- School shirt to be tucked in at all times.

We are fully aware as a school that the cost of living is increasing, along with prices in April and the current cost of petrol. As a school we are always prepared to support and help where we can with uniform. If you do require any additional support with purchasing particular items of uniform please can you contact your child's tutor or Head of Year who will be happy to support.

At Selston High School we have high expectations of our students and the uniform they wear, we want them to be proud of the school and the way they look. As a result of this, those students who do persistently do not meet our uniform expectations, sanctions will be applied.

After Easter we will be monitoring uniform expectations by issuing uniform reminder cards for students who do not meet our standards. Sanctions will be applied as per our ladder of consequences and I would like to thank you all in advance for your support.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind parents that as a school we operate a behaviour system where after school detentions are a sanction which we expect students to attend.
